Reminder: The trash dumpster is for club use only.

Reminder: The Board must approve use of the clubhouse or grounds. No unauthorized use.

Reminder: Campers – remember to check your campsite at least once a month. Sign the camper’s log!

Reminder: No live bait, other than worms is allowed in the pond.

Reminder: No glass bottles are allowed at the ponds or on the archery range. No alcohol is allowed on the archery range at any time.

Reminder: Children are not allowed to run around the campground and clubhouse freely. There must be parental supervision. Bike riding is allowed only on the parking lot.

Reminder: There will be no smoking permitted in the hall during the monthly membership meetings.

Reminder: Members may not use the facilities (camping, fishing, picnic area, etc.) during scheduled work parties. All hands are needed during these workdays.

Reminder: There will be no alcohol consumption during the children’s functions.

Reminder: The club gate must be kept **locked** at all times. This is for the security of both club and personal property. Looping the chain over the post is not permitted.
